\*Algebra I, Geometry I and Algebra II are for students who have already taken these full-year courses at CVU and would like to improve their skills and overall grade. The class is intended for students who have already taken Algebra I, Geometry or Algebra II and want to strengthen skills in order to gain credit for the class, improve their grade up to one letter, or to get a preview of their upcoming math course. The curriculum will be tailored to each individual's needs and over the span of two weeks lessons, workshops and individual instruction will be provided. Students can only gain a credit if they did not pass the year-long course. Students can improve their grade up to a whole letter grade. No credit will be given for previewing an upcoming course. *Daily attendance for all 8 days is mandatory if you are seeking any grade change.*

Class will start on Monday, June 26, and will be completed by Friday, July, 28. We will meet as an entire group Monday-Thursday from 8:15-10:15 until the state required 30 classroom hours have been met. Fridays are reserved for driving lessons only. Classroom attendance is especially important as the Vermont law requires that a student gets 30 hours of classroom instruction. Please do not plan any vacations during the time that class is offered. Driving time is equally important, but there is a little more flexibility in scheduling driving lessons, but they still need to be completed in a timely manner as Vermont law also requires 6 hours on in-vehicle instruction. Driving with 2 students will be offered immediately after class Monday-Thursday from 10:30-12:00 and also for 2-3 students from 12:30-2:30. In most cases, home drop-off is available. I will make every effort to evenly space how many times a student will get a driving lesson right after class and also have to either stay at CVU or go home and come back for the 12:30 lesson. Fridays will be reserved for driving lessons only. See below (next page), for a complete chart of the summer schedule for this course.

\*\*\*Introduction to German Language and Culture: The Introduction to German Language and Culture course promotes depth of cultural knowledge with practical, applicable communication skills. Students explore German history and modern Germany through text, film, newspapers, and music. There is a strong focus in this course on interpersonal communication: students learn how to answer and ask simple questions, speak about themselves, their families, and their town, describe the weather, and tell time and dates. Students will come away from this class with both heightened cultural awareness and basic linguistic competency in German.

\*\*\*\*Creative Writing: On the Trail is concentrated and intensive. In other words, there will be a lot of work in a short amount of time. Students will be expected to be prepared intellectually for each "class" which includes completing the reading and writing assignments. Though not a PE course, it will be physically demanding, and students are expected to be fit enough to hike several miles in the morning.

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\*\*\*\***Writing Prose Through Moodle:** Students will meet with Mr. LaChance as a group for two, three-hour classes in June, work independently, and then meet again for two, three-hour classes in August. In between the two days, students will complete assignments through Moodle on a Google Doc and receive online feedback. The instructor will be available online during certain times and will be available for one-with-one meetings at CVU at certain times. Students are expected to primarily communicate online. The goal will be that students learn the knowledge required to become excellent self-editors and effective (independent) reviewers of work while also learning the skills to independently complete the assignments at a high level.

Grades will be assessed based on student final products, the portfolio of completed work, and the results from the Final Summative. Growth in skill and knowledge will be rewarded, but an Honors grade and/or High Honors grade will only be earned if the final products meet the clearly-defined standards. **Please note, for students enrolling in this course, signatures are required on both pages of this form.**

**+Natural Resources Summer Term:** This course provides an understanding of the physical environment and ecosystem dynamics as well as how social values impact their management. Students will explore projects ranging from fish and wildlife management, food and energy systems, and water resources through the lens of sustainability. Design Technology will provide the vehicle and platform in which student investigate solutions to our real world problems. This course runs 8 weeks beginning June 26th. Classes meet Tues-Weds-Thurs morning. This is a 48+ hour course with opportunities to make up missed classes on off days. **Please note, for students enrolling in this course, signatures are required on both pages of this form.**
